VOCABULARY

Before watching the video ... let's focus on some new words

1 METEOROIDS

A small body moving in the solar system that would became a meteor if it entered the Earth's atmosphere

2 SOIL

The upper layer of earth

3 REGOLITH

The layer of unconsolidated rocky material; soil layer of the Moon

4 SHELL

Something resembling or likened to a shell because of its shape or its function

5 DUST

Fine, dry powder consisting of tiny particles of earth or waste matter lying on the ground (Moon dust)

6 FLUCTUATION

An irregular rising and failing in number or amount; a variation

7 HEAD

The upper part or end of something (printing head)

8 FOAM

A mass of small bubbles formed on or in liquid

9 BONE

Any of the pieces of hard tissue making up skeleton in humans and other vertebrates

10 DOME

A rounded vault forming the roof of a building or structure, typically with a circular base (inflatable dome)

11 SCOOP

A utensil resembling a spoon used for removing substances from a container

12 BINDING

Something that cannot be broken

13 LANDER

A spacecraft designed to land on the surface of a planet or Moon

14 ROCKET

A cylindrical projectile that can be propelled to a great distance by the combustion of its contents

15 LAUNCH

An act or an instance of launching something

16 SCAFFOLDING

A temporary structure

17 AIRLOCK

A compartment with controlled pressure and parallels set of doors, to permit movement between areas at different pressures

18 SKYLIGHT

A window installed in a roof or ceiling

19 (to) ENDURE

Remain in existence

20 HABITATION

The state or process of living in a particular place
