Father Alex Zanotelli was born in Trentino and then moved to the USA where he studied Theology. He is a member of the Combonian Missionaries. He is the founder of movements that promote equality and harmony. He spent most of his life helping poor people in many parts of Africa such as Sudan and Kenia.



Gino Strada is an Italian war surgeon and founder of an UN-recognised Italian non-governmental organisation called Emergency, that operates in war zones, such as Iraq, Afghanistan, Sudan, Sierra Leone, etc. Emergency Organisation gives aid to injured people.



Amalia De Simone is an Italian video reporter and iournalist who investigates the links between organised crime, politics and economy. She was considered a hero by the President of the Italian Republic for her brave investigate reports against the criminality.



Beatrice (Bebe) Vio is an Italian wheelchair fencer and a **Paralympic world champion** since the age of 19. She is very brave in fact she overcomes many difficulties every day because of her disability and never gives up.



Giuseppe Falcone (1939-1992) and Paolo Borsellino (1940-1992) were both Italian judges and magistrates. They spent most of their professional life trying to get rid of the Mafia. They sent to prison hundreds of criminal people in a very big trial (Maxi Trial). Both of them were assassinated by the Sicilian Mafia, nowadays they still remain icons of justice.
