Heading tags

- h1 $\rightarrow$ heading 1 (the biggest)
- h2 $\rightarrow$ heading 2
- h3 $\rightarrow$ heading 4
- h4 $\rightarrow$ heading 5
- h5 $\rightarrow$ heading 6
- h6 $\rightarrow$ heading 7


## Paragraph tags

- $\mathrm{p} \rightarrow$ paragraph
- br $\rightarrow$ break line


## Other text tags

<hr> \(\rightarrow\) horizontal rule
<b> $\rightarrow$ bold

- $\mathrm{i} \gg$ italics
<u> -underline
