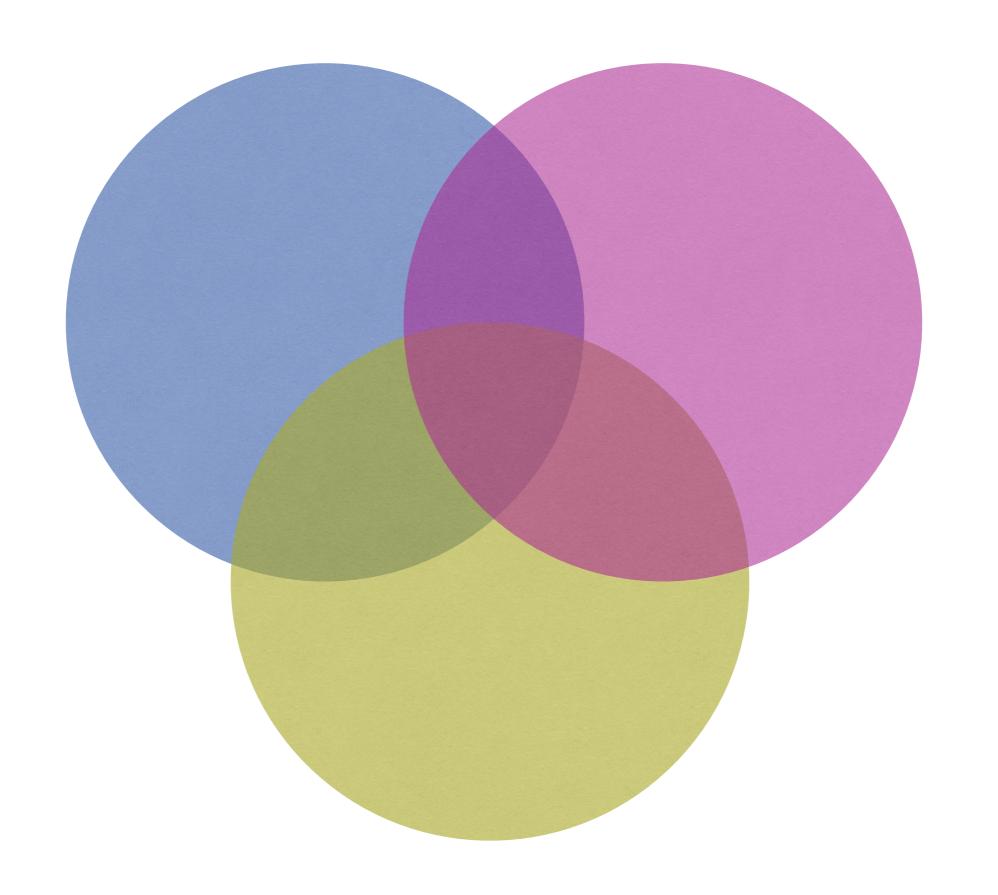
WHATIS GRAPHIC DESIGN?

Graphic design is the art or skill of combining images, words and ideas in advertisements, magazines or books, to convey information to an audience.

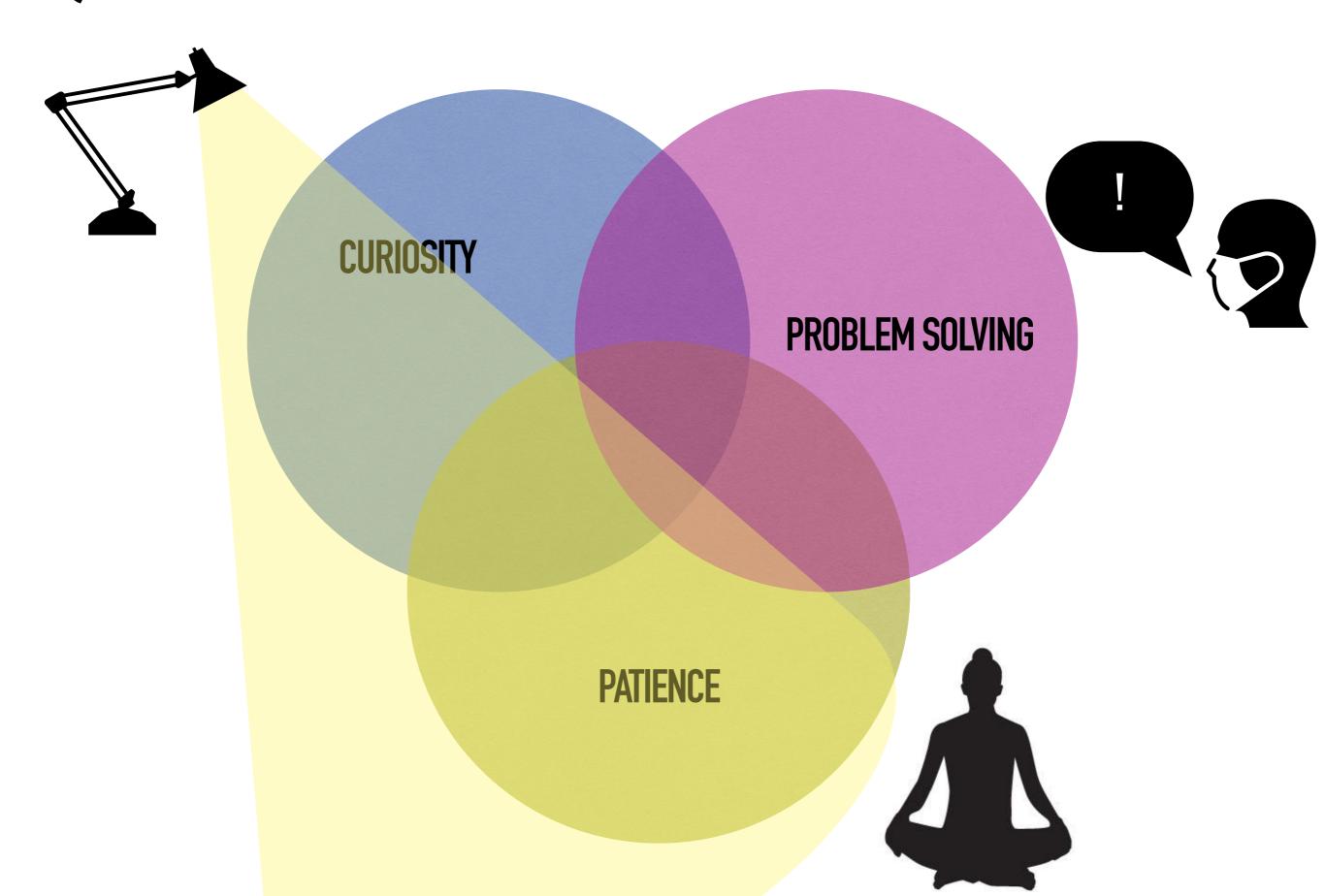

A graphic designer **communicates visually**.

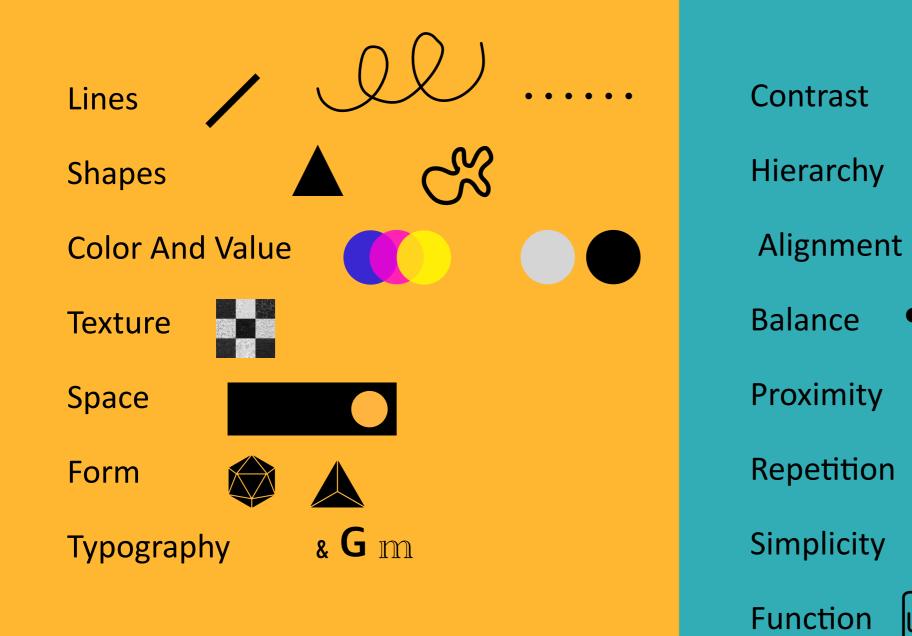
The building blocks of visual grammar are: lines, shapes, color and value, texture, space, form (volume/mass) and typography.

To decide upon the look and function of something **before** it is made.

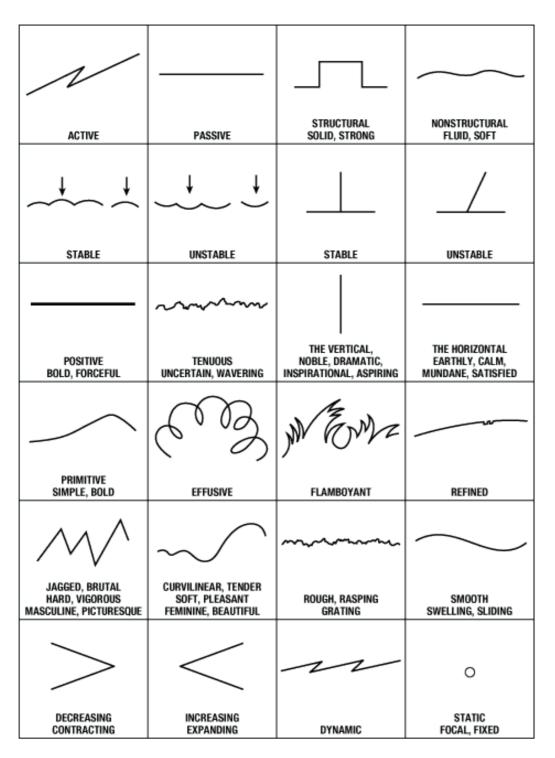
To design (v): to create, fashion, execute, or construct according to plan.

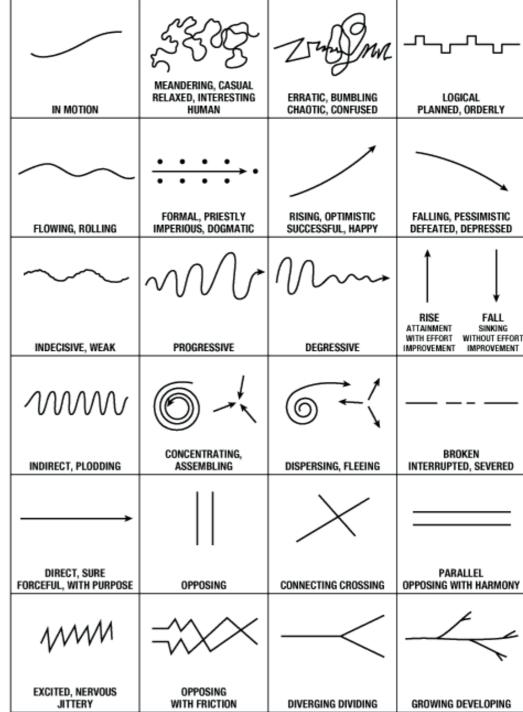
The rules that a designer should follow to create an effective and attractive composition are: contrast, hierarchy and proportion, alignment, balance, proximity and negative space, repetition, simplicity and function.

WARM COLORS

Bright and light colors make you feel more **optimistic** and **happy**.

Warm colors like yellow, orange, pink, and red and pastel colors like peach, light pink or lilac can have un **uplifting effect** on the mood.





COOL COLORS

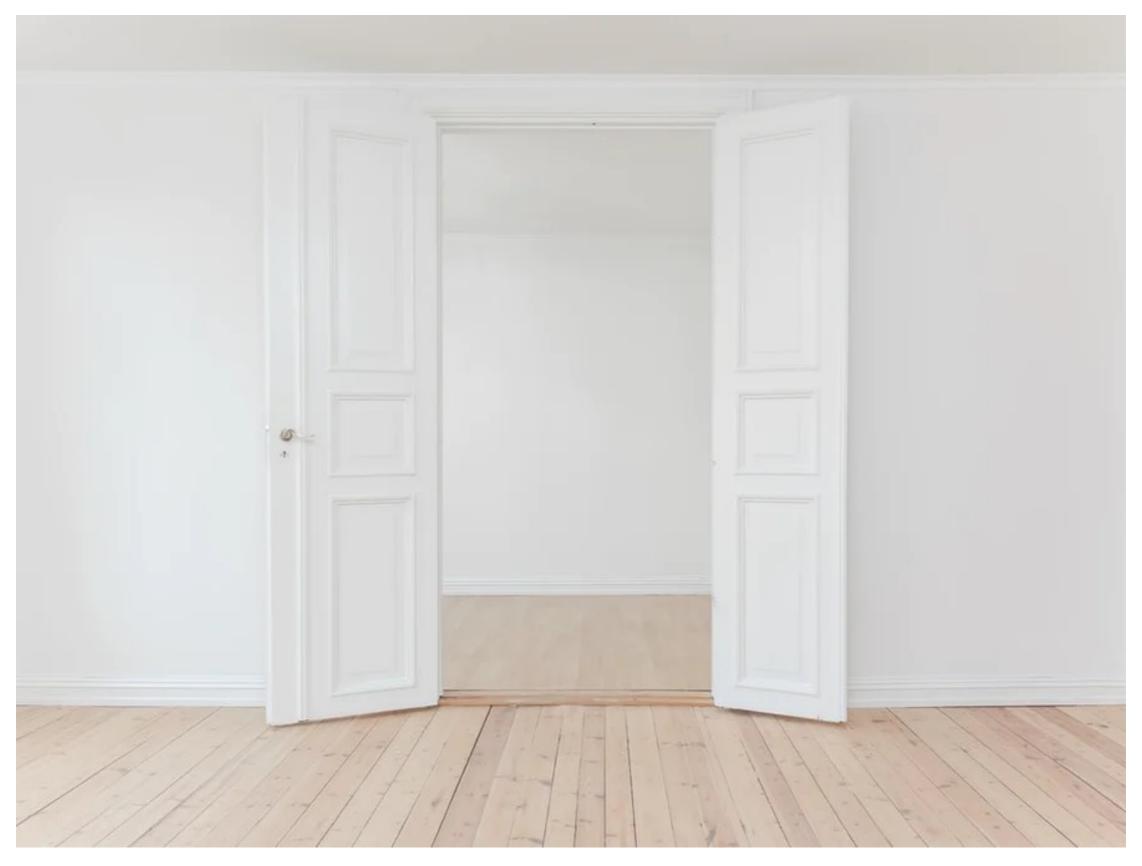
Cool colors like blue and green can make you feel **calm**.

Grey and dark colors are being perceived as sad colors.





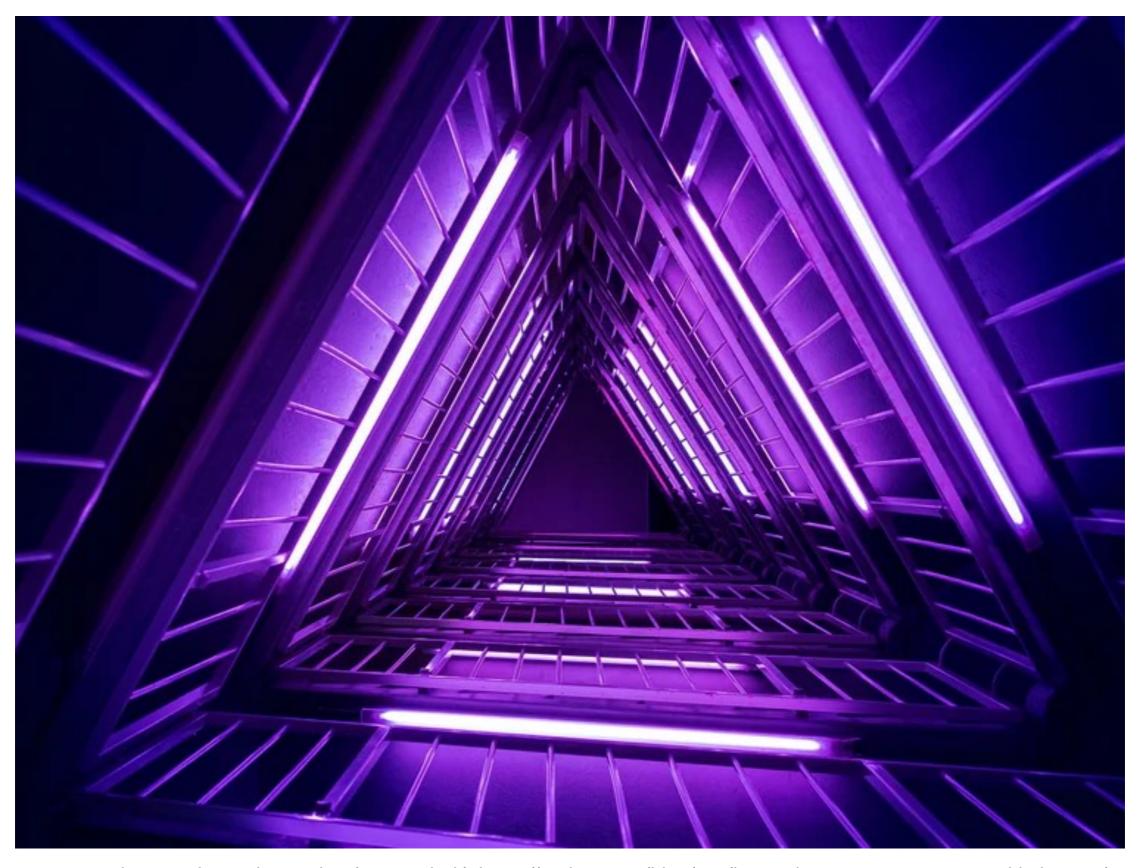
Pink represents femininity and romance, sensitivity and tenderness. It's a delicate color that is often associated with bubble gum, flowers, babies, cotton candy, little girls and sweetness. It can represent friendship, affection, harmony, inner peace and approachability.



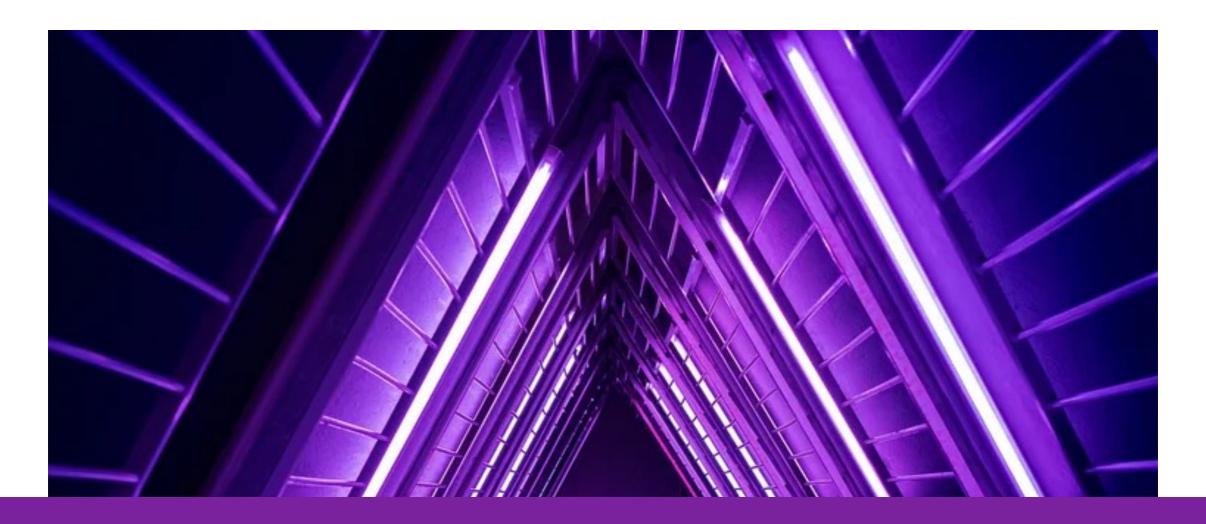

White means minimalism and simplicity. It is often associated with purity, light, safety, illumination, spirituality, humility and sincerity. The color of snow, in the western countries is the traditional color worn by brides, to signify purity and innocence. In eastern countries, white is the color of mourning and funerals. The color white affects mind and body by promoting feelings of fresh beginnings and renewal.

Purple is often associated with **creativity**, **mystery**, **royalty**, **power**, **wisdom**, **pride**, **independence** and **magic**. It has a variety of effects on mind and body, such as **uplifting spirits** and **calming mind and nerves**. Lighter shades of purple are used to soothe or calm a viewer. Since it's a combination of **blue** (calm stability) and **red** (fierce energy), the color retains both warm and cool properties.





REMEMBER:

When discussing about **color meaning** and **psychology** there are no right or wrong answers.

Colors and feelings are linked. But how someone feels about a color is subjective, it is not agreed on universally.

What might make **one** person feel happy and cheerful, can make **another** person feel sad or irritated, depending on the viewers' past experiences or cultural differences.

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
