- 1. Imperialism refers to the annexation of territories by the Great Powers. (T)
- 2. Imperialism took place between 1492 and 1789. (F 1870-1914)
- 3. Imperialism had no precedents (F initial phase of colonization)
- 4. Imperialism was caused by economic factors alone (F also by social, cultural and political factors)
- 5. The Great Depression had no direct influence on imperialism (F)
- 6. When the richest economies abandoned their free trade policies, imperialism was strengthened (T)
- 7. European expansionism was motivated by political and economic factors (T)
- 8. Only the major European colonial powers sought to increase their international influence (F also the minor colonial powers)
- 9. The working class opposed expansionist policies (F)
