EUROPE & IBERIAN PENINSULA

<u>Europe</u> is one of the world's largest peninsulas and is also a continent. Europe is made up of lots smaller peninsulas but the four largest peninsulas in Europe are Italian, Balkan, **Iberian** and Scandinavian Peninsulas.


PENINSULA is a piece of land almost surrounded by water and connected to the mainland on **at least** (=almeno) one side.

The Iberian Peninsula is the continent's second-largest peninsula.

It is located on Europe's southwestern tip (=estremo/punta). It is part of the southern Europe peninsula, between Atlantic Ocean to the north/west, and the Mediterranean Sea, to the south/east.

The Iberian Peninsula's southern tip is separated from the Africa continent by the narrow (=stretto/corto) Strait of Gibraltar. At the narrowest point, the peninsula is only 14 km from Morocco.

The Iberian Peninsula covers approximately 583.000 km²: <u>it's around 5.9% of Europe's total area.</u>
Iberia has a population of 52,3 million people.





It extends from Punta de Tarifa on the extreme **south** to Punta de Estaca de Bares to the **north**. From the **west**, the peninsula begins at Cabo da Roca and extends to Cap de Creus in the **east**. It forms an irregular octagonal shape (=forma).

The Iberian Peninsula is separated from the rest of Europe by the <u>Pyrenees</u> mountain range located between France and Spain. The peninsula is mainly occupied by **Spain** and **Portugal**. However, it also comprises **Andorra**, part of Southern **France** and **Gibraltar**, a British overseas (=oltremare) territory.
