

WATER BORDERS




Iceland's rugged coastline, of more than 4,800 km meets the Greenland Sea on the north, the Norwegian Sea on the east, the Atlantic Ocean on the south and west, and the Denmark Strait (which separates it from Greenland by about 320 km on the northwest).

PHYSICAL FEATURES

Glacier ice and cooled lava each cover approximately one-tenth of the country's total area!

The area covered by Vatnajökull (Vatna Glacier), the country's largest, is equal to the combined total area covered by all the glaciers on the continent of Europe.



The volcanoes are explained by the fact that Iceland is located on top of the Mid-Atlantic Ridge




Iceland contains about 200 volcanoes!
